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WATER EFFICIENT LANDSCAPE REQUIREMENTS

On December 1, 2015, as required by the State of California, the City adopted the updated Model Water Efficient Landscape Ordinance, which increased water efficiency standards for new and rebuilt landscapes through more efficient irrigation systems, increased the use of greywater systems and onsite storm water capture, and limits on the amount of new turf areas.

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Appl	licability
The V	Water Efficient Landscape Ordinance applies to the following projects:
	New construction projects with new or rebuilt landscape areas that exceed 500 square feet Remodels and/or additions to existing single-family houses with new or rebuilt landscape areas that exceed 2,500 square feet Properties listed on the City's Historic Resources Inventory are exempt
	ning Review
Any a break lands	application that is submitted for Planning review (e.g. Design Review, Variance) shall include a adown of the total hardscape area, existing landscape area to remain and new or rebuilt scape area. If the new and rebuilt landscape area exceeds the threshold outlined above, the act will be subject to the requirements in the Water Efficient Landscape Ordinance.
Build	ding Permit Review
In order to submit for a building permit, a project must provide a landscape documentation package that includes the following information:	
	Cover Sheet with project information On the Cover Sheet, include the following statements: • "I have complied with the criteria of the ordinance and applied them for the efficient use of water in the landscape and irrigation design plan," signed by the licensed landscape professional; and • "I agree to comply with the requirements of the water efficient landscape ordinance and submit a complete Landscape Documentation Package," signed by the applicant and/or owner.

Landscape Installation

All landscaping and irrigation specified in the approved landscape documentation package shall be installed before a building permit can be signed-off and finalized. To verify that the landscaping and irrigation was installed per the approved plans, a certificate of completion shall be submitted to the City. A sample certificate of completion is included in Appendix C of the Water Efficient Landscape Ordinance.
